INTRODUCTION

The group saw its inception in 2023 and is not committed to any one genre or era in music history, but rather seeks to bring classical music to as wide an audience as possible. Classical in the sense that the given work is a first-rate representation of its given era or genre and should be performed in the high quality it deserves.

This quality is ensured by the fact that all members of the ensemble are passionate and skilled vocalists, be it as soloists or as a member of vocal ensembles in Hungary and around the world.

The group's first performance was in Rome, which was followed by its Hungarian debut in the Palace of the Arts and its first public Hungarian appearance at the Lóvasút Cultural Center. In the summer of 2023 *Cantica Aeterna* was invited by the Helsinki Hungarian Institute and performed several concerts throughout the city as a part of the Night of the Arts. In the fall of 2023, the ensemble gave a full evening concert as a part of the Sursum Corda Festival.
